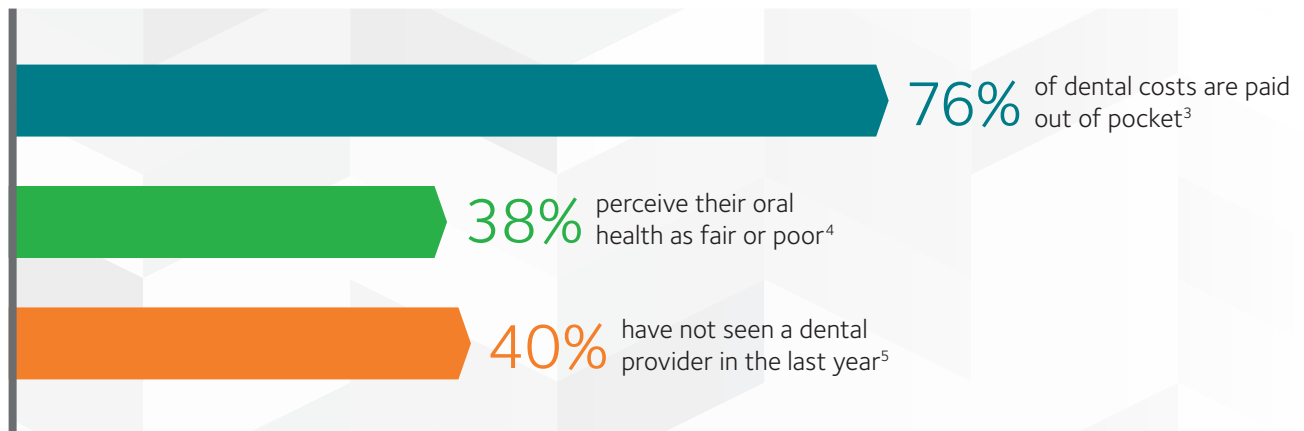


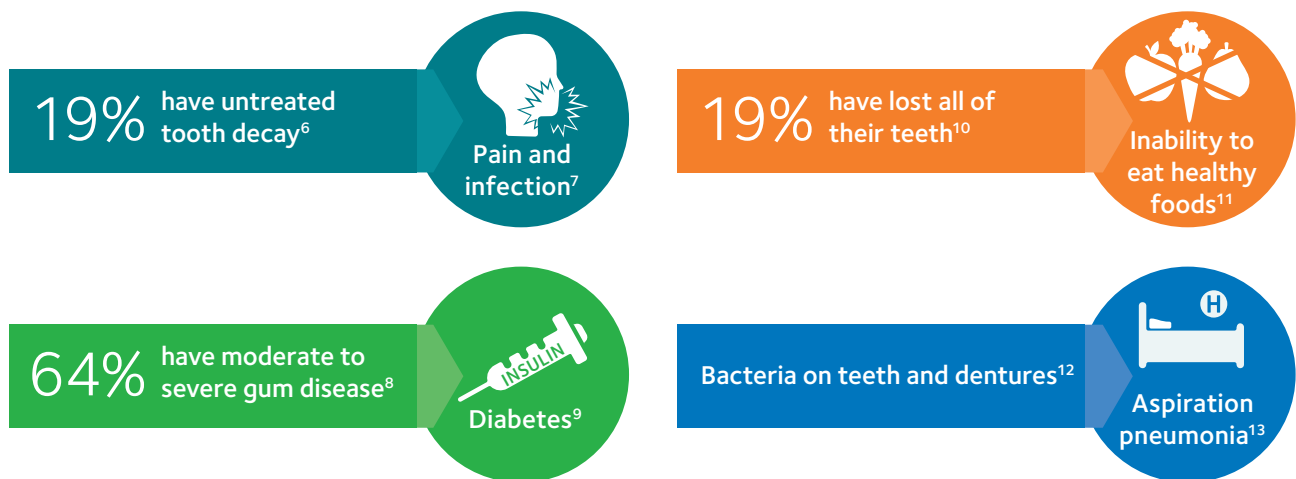
Why Oral Health in Older Adults is Important
